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Introduction

Use the following steps to upgrade the System 4 PC and Monitor.

Directions

1. Remove the Dyna Signal and Dyna Motor cables from the back of the CDS Cart. Unplug the CDS cart power from the back of the T-base.

2. Remove the monitor cable cover from the back of the display to expose the cables.

3. Tilt the monitor to the left and remove all of the display cables at the bottom of the display.

4. Remove the four mounting screws from the monitor using a Phillips screw driver.

5. After removing the mounting screws, remove the monitor from the stand.

6. Discard the monitor and screws.

7. Unplug the printer cables from the rear of the printer.

8. Remove the printer from the cart.

9. Remove the left side cover to expose the cables.

The white arrow in Figure 9 indicates the routing of the cables to the monitor.

10. Using a Phillips screw driver, remove the three screws holding the power strip cover plate.

11. Remove the cover plate as illustrated in Figure 11.



Power strip for the computer, monitor, and printer is located in this section.

12. Using a Phillips screw driver, remove the three screws from the top of the controller drawer.

- 13. a) Lift up the controller drawer.
 - b) Remove the drawer from the cart.
 - c) Once removed, turn it onto its side as illustrated in Figure 13.

NOTE: Do not pull the cables while removing the controller drawer.

14. To remove the side cover illustrated in Figure 14, lift up on its bottom.

15. Remove the cover to expose the back of the PC as illustrated in Figure 15.

16. Remove all of the cables from the back of the PC.

17. Remove the PC from the cart.

18. Install the PC adapter bracket assembly inside of the cart as illustrated in Figures 18 and 19. *NOTE: Some systems may already have the bracket installed.*

19. Remove all of the cable ties (see Figure 20 for tie locations). **NOTE:** Be careful not to cut the cables when cutting the cable ties.

The user has the option to keep the existing wired Keyboard and Mouse or remove them and use the new wireless Keyboard and Mouse included with the new PC.

20. Remove all the existing monitor cables from the CDS cart.

21. Disconnect the existing monitor power adapter from the CDS power strip (see Figure 22) and discard it.

22. Remove the new widescreen Monitor from the box. Discard the USB and HDMI 5 foot cables that came with the monitor. The new monitor will use the 10 ft USB cable (C14397) and the 6 ft HDMI cable (C14512) that is included in the kit. The monitor power cable included with the monitor will be used (see Figure 23).



Do not discard the new monitor power cable.

23. Install the new widescreen monitor on the stand with the four Phillips head screws included in the upgrade kit.

24. Tilt the monitor to the left and install the power cable under the table-stand bracket on the monitor.

25. Install the 10 foot USB and 6 foot HDMI cable to the monitor under the table stand bracket and tie cables as illustrated in Figures 26 and 27.

26. Tie the monitor wires under the top of the CDS.

27. Figure 29 illustrates the locations at which the cables are to be tied.

28. Route the HDMI cable through the power strip section, then through the top slot and connect to the new PC as illustrated in Figure 30.

Route the USB cable to the marked location with the other remaining cables. All cables must go under the bracket and in the cutout as illustrated in Figure 30.

29. Add one final tie for the HDMI cable as illustrated in Figure 31.

30. Route printer cables inside the power strip compartment as illustrated in Figure 32 depending on which side of the cabinet the printer power and USB are located. For the instructions given here, the printer cables must be on the right side.

NOTE: If the upgrade kit contains a new printer, use the existing USB printer cable and install the new printer's power cord, if needed. Plug it into the power strip.

31. Install the drawer back into the CDS cart.

NOTE: Be careful with the wires when re-installing the drawer on the CDS cart.

32. Install the power strip plate on the CDS cart.

35. Install the 1 foot serial cable extender, (C12968) included with the kit, to the existing serial cable. When finished, install all cables to the PC in their respective locations.



36. Install batteries in the wireless keyboard.

37. Remove the top cover of the mouse and install the battery.

38. Remove the wireless Dongle from inside the mouse and install it into any of the USB ports of the PC.

39. Power up the System 4 to ensure everything is working properly.

The Upgrade is now completed and ready for operation.
